Membership Models & Fees*

kuntsverein offers three models of membership to choose from. Please read the descriptions below carefully and tick your preferred membership model. The fees are calculated based on kuntsverein's expenses, which encompass mainly the maintenance of our project space, 8B[®]1 (rent, running costs, snacks, and supplies) and allow us to function in moments of shortage or complete lack of subsidies.

(!) Note: Our fees operate on the basis of a sliding-scale, which addresses one's financial situation and access to institutional support. We believe in artists supporting one another in accessing collective infrastructures.

* The Sliding-scale

— Solidarity Fee

For those with consistent institutional support, higher income state-funding, or those with a higher income through freelance work, selling of artworks, or inheritance. This membership tier is intended for working artists who have a more established situation and can afford their living costs comfortably. This tier allows for other artists with different financial circumstances to still become members.

— Base Fee

For those with irregular institutional support or income through project-based funding, freelance work, or full-/part-time employment.

— Reduced Fee

For those without institutional support or regular income.

(!) Note: If the reduced fee is still not accessible to you, do not hesitate to reach out to us to discuss other forms of exchange.

All-In, the U-Haul (monthly)

All-In members are active in the kuntsverein's functioning. They can join board meetings and have a vote in the general assembly. They have full access to the space, while also being responsible for its maintenance (cleaning, administration, attending organisation meetings, hosting opening hours).

Friends With Benefits (yearly)

Friends With Benefits members are active in the structural organising as well as in the planning of activities in/for the kuntsverein. They can join board meetings and have a vote in the general assembly. While these members do not have ongoing access to the space in Weiglasse to work, they are able to organise events, workshops, and projects, as well as rent the space at a discounted price. This membership's fee is yearly.
